



RAW WOOL

Wool coated with grease. (also mud, seeds and thorns picked up in the fields.)

SCOURING PROCESS

WASHING

Wool is washed clean in a series of baths containing detergent and hot water.

RINSING

Wool is thoroughly rinsed and squeezed through rollers.

DRYING

Wool is dried.

SCOURED WOOL

Clean wool.

LANOLIN

Wool loses about 30% of its weight when the grease is removed. This is purified to make lanolin and used in face and hand cream, soap and ointment.
