



Winter: more hay please

The care of 'in lamb' ewes is checked throughout the winter months. It is important that they have enough food. Sometimes they are moved from the hills onto lower grassy pastures and the farmer gives extra hay and feed. If the sheep don't get enough food at this time their wool becomes weak and the fibres can break.

The ewes are vaccinated to keep them healthy and also their unborn lambs.
