



British Wool – Sale Report

BW103 – 11th August 2020



Key Points

BW103 saw prices for British Wool hold firm with some types slightly dearer and a total sale volume of 758 tonnes. Interest was strongest in the Fine and Medium types but there was limited demand for Mountain types.

- Total weight offered 1.569m kg Total weight sold 0.758m kg
- Clearance 48%
- Average clean price £0.774 / kg Average greasy price £0.530 / kg

The clearances by wool type were as follows;

- Fine wool 68%,
- Medium wool 73%,
- Mule wool 33%,
- Hill wool 55%,
- Mountain wool 13%,
- Lamb 62%.

Price movements for key wool types

Prices where comparable to BW102;

Fine: Hoggs No1 – unsold. Hoggs No2 – firm. Ewes No1 – firm to sellers favour. Ewes No2 – firm to 2% dearer.

Romney: All grades firm.

Medium: Hoggs No1 – firm. Hoggs No2 – firm where comparable. Ewes No1 – firm. Ewes No2 – up to 2% dearer. Ewes Discoloured – firm.

Mules: Hoggs No1 – unsold. Hoggs No2 – firm where comparable. Ewes No1 & No2 – firm. Cott grades – firm where sold.

Cheviots: Hoggs No1 – fully firm. Ewes No2 – fully firm. Cross grades – firm where comparable.

Hill: All grades firm to sellers favour.

Swaledale: Firm where sold.

Blackface: Firm to sellers favour where sold.

Welsh: All grades unsold.

Lamb: All grades where sold were at a similar level to the previous sale.
