BW104 – 25th August 2020



Key Points

BW104 saw prices for British Wool hold firm for most types and a total sale volume of 992 tonnes.

- Total weight offered 1.554m kg Total weight sold 0.992m kg
- Clearance 64%
- Average clean price £0.752 / kg Average greasy price £0.516 / kg

The clearances by wool type were as follows;

- Fine wool 71%,
- Medium wool 79%,
- Mule wool 57%,
- Hill wool 73%,
- Mountain wool 47%,
- Lamb 27%.

Price movements for key wool types

Prices where comparable to BW103;

Fine: Hoggs No1 – unsold. Hoggs No2 – firm to sellers favour. Ewes No1 & No2 – firm.

Romney: All grades fully firm.

Medium: Hoggs No1 – fully firm. Hoggs No2 – firm to sellers favour. Ewes No1 – fully 2% dearer. Ewes No2 – firm to sellers favour. Ewes Discoloured – firm.

Mules: Hoggs No1 & No2 – buyers favour where sold. Ewes No1 – firm to sellers favour. Ewes No2 – firm. Cott grades – firm where sold.

Cheviots: Hoggs No2 – buyers favour to 2% cheaper. Ewes No1 – fully 5% dearer. Ewes No2 – firm. Cross grades – sellers favour.

Hill: All grades firm.

Swaledale: Firm to sellers favour where comparable.

Blackface: Firm to buyers favour.

Welsh: All grades buyers favour compared to when lost sold.

Lamb: All grades where sold fully firm.
