



British Wool – Sale Report

BW118 – 16th March 2021



Key Points

BW118 had a 100% clearance with the both the average price and British Wool index strengthening by more than 10 percent. The average greasy sale price of 66.3p / kg was up almost 8p versus last sale and the British Wool Index increased by 13.0% sale on sale.

Fine: Hoggs No1 – fully 10% dearer. Hoggs No2 – fully 7.5% dearer. Ewes No1 – fully 10% dearer. Ewes No2 – up to 10% dearer. Lt Grey – 15% dearer.

Romney: All grades fully 10% dearer.

Medium: Hoggs No1 – fully 5% dearer. Hoggs No2 – 10% dearer. Ewes No1 – fully 12.5% dearer. Ewes No2 – fully 10% dearer. Naturally discoloured – fully 10% dearer. Lt Grey – fully 7.5% dearer.

Mules: Hoggs No1 & No2 – up to 12.5% dearer. Ewes No1 & No2 – fully 12.5% dearer. All Cott grades – up to 15% dearer. Lt Grey – fully 7.5% dearer.

Cheviots: Hoggs No2 – fully 10% dearer. Ewes No1 – up to 12.5% dearer. Ewes No2 – up to 10% dearer. Cross grades – up to 15% dearer.

Hill: Fine – fully 10% dearer. Medium – fully 15% dearer.

Swaledale: No1 – fully 10% dearer. Grey – fully 5% dearer.

Blackface: Medium No1 – fully 5% dearer. No2 – fully 10% dearer. Cotts – fully 7.5% dearer.

Welsh: No1 – sellers favour. No2 – fully 10% dearer. Coloured kempy – 10% dearer.

Lamb: Where comparable lamb grades sold at 5 to 15% dearer.
