



British Wool – Sale Report

BW120 – 13th April 2021



Key Points

BW120 had a 100% clearance with prices generally firm to sellers favour. The average greasy sale price of 66.1p / kg was in line with the previous sale on a similar mix and the British Wool Index increased by 0.4%.

Price movements for key wool types

Prices where comparable to BW119;

Fine: Hoggs No1 – sellers favour. Hoggs No2 – firm. Ewes No1 – fully firm. Ewes No2 – buyers favour.

Romney: All grades firm.

Medium: Hoggs No1 – 2.5% dearer. Hoggs No2 – up to 2% dearer. Ewes No1 & No2 – firm to sellers favour. Naturally discoloured – fully firm. Lt Grey – sellers favour.

Mules: Hoggs No1 – firm to 5% dearer. Hoggs No2 – buyers favour to 5% dearer. Ewes No1 & No2 – buyers favour. All Cott grades – firm to 4% dearer. Lt Grey – sellers favour.

Cheviots: Hoggs No2 – sellers favour. Ewes No2 – fully firm. Cross grades – firm to sellers favour.

Hill: Fine & Medium – fully firm.

Swaledale: all grades fully firm.

Blackface: Medium No1 – fully firm. No2 – sellers favour. Cotts – up to 2.5% cheaper.

Welsh: No1 – fully firm. No2 – up to 2% dearer. Coloured kempy – up to 2% dearer.

Lamb: Where comparable was firm to sellers favour.
