



British Wool – Sale Report

BW121 – 27th April 2021



Key Points

BW121 had a 99% clearance with prices generally firm to sellers favour and just two lots unsold. The average greasy sale price of 66.8p / kg was 1% higher than the previous sale on a similar mix and the British Wool Index increased by 0.9%.

- Total weight offered 1.490m kg Total weight sold 1.476m kg
- Clearance 99%
- Average clean price £1.004 / kg Average greasy price £0.668 / kg
- British Wool Index 1.021 per kg vs. 1.012 per kg in BW120

Price movements for key wool types

Prices where comparable to BW120;

Fine: Hoggs No1 & No2 – firm. Ewes No1 & No2 – 2% dearer. Lt Grey – buyers favour.

Romney: Ewes No1 – up to 2% dearer. Ewes No2 – 4% dearer.

Medium: Hoggs No1 & No2 – firm. Ewes No1 – up to 2% dearer. Ewes No2 – up to 3% dearer. Naturally discoloured – firm. Grey – buyers favour.

Mules: Hoggs No1 & No2 – firm to 2.5% dearer. Ewes No1 – 2% dearer. Ewes No2 – 2.5% dearer. Soft Cotts – firm to sellers favour. Cotts – sellers favour. Lt Grey – buyers favour.

Cheviots: Hoggs No1 – firm. Ewes No2 – sellers favour. Cross grades – up to 3% dearer.

Hill: Fine & Medium – 2.5% dearer.

Swaledale: all grades firm.

Blackface: Medium No1 – firm to sellers favour. No2 – fully 2.5% dearer. Cotts – sellers favour.

Welsh: No1 – 2.5% dearer. No2 – firm. Coloured kempy – firm.

Lamb: Prices on a small selection were firm.
