SALE REPORT

The British Wool sale on 21st October consolidated the gains delivered in BW207 on 7th October. Most core types were fully firm to sellers favour with Welsh Mountain trading around 5% dearer. Bidding started slightly tentatively but firmed as the market found its level, with all buyers who logged on participating. The average greasy price of 119.3p per kg was 1.5p higher than last sale and the index was up 1.4% at 1.760.

All lots sold, delivering a 100% clearance. The total offer was 1,102 tonnes. British Wool continues to expect supplies for the year to be slightly down on last season.

The next British Wool sale is in two weeks' time on 4th November.


