SALE REPORT

The British Wool sale on 18th November saw prices fully firm to 2% dearer with consistent demand throughout the catalogue.

The British Wool index was up 0.9% sale on sale at 1.814. The average greasy sale price was slightly lower than in BW209 at £1.184 per kg. The was due to the mix of wools in the offer – there was no high value Bluefaced Leicester available this sale. The clearance was 100% with all but one lot being sold during the main phase of the action. All British Wool's main buyers were active in the sale.

Test results for 2025 season wool continue to be significantly better than last year for colour with British Wool producing a greater proportion of No.1 grades in the core types. British Wool's intake volumes this season are currently running just over 4% down year on year and current expectations are for the total supply of wool this season to be several hundred tonnes lower than last year. The recent price increase has been well covered in the agricultural press and farmers awareness of the better prices is strong, but this has not resulted in any more wool being presented for sale.

The volumes sold, clearances by wool type, and price changes in BW210 were as below. The next British Wool sale is in two weeks' time on 2nd of December.

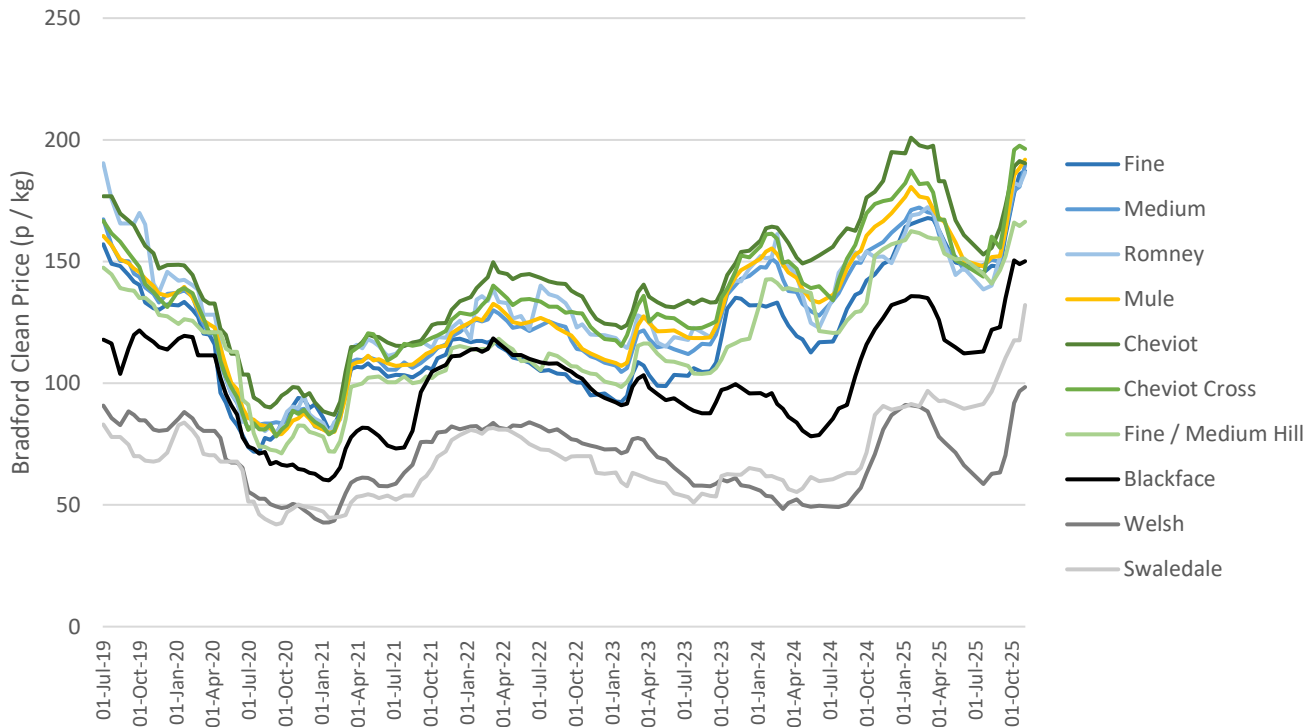


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PRICE MOVEMENTS FOR KEY WOOL TYPES: JULY 2019 TO DATE
